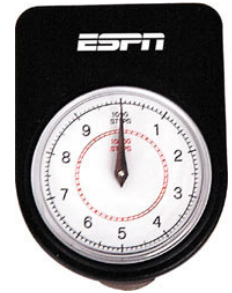


Pedometers

The most **basic style** is under \$6. It just clips on the belt and does this one function.

The other two styles range from about \$10 to \$13, the talking style being the most expensive. They just go up from there. Oregon Research even makes a few, but I'll bet they are pricey. I did not look these up.



Both the translucent styles and the talking styles are new products. We may see price cuts in the new year.



The oval style features five mode settings including: General timer mode; Pacer mode to count steps (up to 9,999); Calorie Calculation mode; Distance Calculation; and Alarm mode with 10 memory settings. Memory settings permit you to enter up to 10 dates upon which the alarm will sound at 8:00 AM. Sleek design features translucent case, belt clip, and clear hinged window to protect the setting buttons and display. Available in translucent green, blue, red, and clear with your imprint on the top clear cover. Individually gift boxed. *Button cell batteries included.* These are below \$9 at 500.

The other silver style labeled "talking" announces current time with reminder alarm, plays melodies in sync with your walking speed. Measures and announces total distance traveled. Counts and announces up to 99,999 steps. Easy audible set-up mode. Ergonomic design slim profile with belt clip. Great for walking and jogging. *Batteries included.* Under \$10 for 500.
